Kingston Wharves Seaport Terminal

JAMAICA

Participants will be immersed in operations at the Kingston Wharves Terminal and exposed to best practice methodologies used by high-performing Multi-purpose Ports. The course will also provide opportunity for attendees to make parallel assessments terminal operations in Colombia and their countries of origin with a view to determining new ways of mitigating common operations and management challenges.

MONDAY

Commercial Operations >> An operational overview of the commercial processes used by Kingston Wharves Limited

Safety & Security >> Role & functions of the Safety & Security Department within the context of increasingly sophisticated threats and developing international security regulations

TUESDAY

Vessel Planning >> An in-depth look at vessel planning operations and the factors which contribute to efficient berth allocation, ship layout, discharge, and loading

Yard Planning >> Exploring the complex process of container yard planning and its critical link to vessel and gate productivity (Pre-planning fundamentals; Space Utilization and Efficiency)

WEDNESDAY

RoRo Operations >> Best practices in handling RoRo cargo; its connectedness with yard, vessel planning and security

Equipment Operations >> Utilization and assignment and proactive time of terminal equipment vis-a-vis anticipated needs

THURSDAY

Equipment Operations Cont'd

Human Resource Management >> Labour allocation and deployment, live-action training, employee relations

Maintenance >> Response to equipment failures; Preventative maintenance; maintenance during operations; engineering and maintenance stores

FRIDAY

Stowage >> Review of stowage operations and sequencing techniques as well as strategies to maximize container movement efficiency and minimize congestion during vessel operations

About the Kingston Wharves:

KWL operates one of two seaport terminals at Port Bustamante, just east and adjoining Kingston Container Terminal. A continuous quay nearly 1,600 meters long provides nine deepwater berths for ro-ro, lo-lo, container, general break bulk and bulk shipping services.

The 25 hectare terminal offers 22 hectare of open storage with 30,000 square meters of covered warehousing and cold storage. The company also has 53,000 square meters of secure off-dock storage for motor vehicles.

The Company operates 24 hours per day, 365 days per year. Its highly trained staff and comprehensive range of terminal equipment, including five mobile harbour cranes, are available to perform the most demanding stevedoring functions. Modern terminal management software maximizes the efficiency of wharf and warehouse operations. They utilize handheld and vehicle mounted computers together with Tideworks yard management software, which has led to a reduction in vessel turn-around. These devices have also enhanced yard management operations and lead to more accurate inventory control.

Committed to continual improvement, Kingston Wharves Ltd has made substantial investments in the past five years upgrading the terminal's infrastructure and administrative operations. The Company's modernization programme includes dredging the harbour, which will give rise to deeper drafts, in order to accommodate larger vessels. KWL will then be in a better position to take advantage of marketing opportunities presented by the anticipated growth in trade throughout the region.
